

The Connecticut State Referee Program has moved to a new website <http://www.ctreferee.net> Please save the new web address in your favorites/bookmarks and add info@ctreferee.net to your e-mail "safe sender" list.

The CSRP has prepared a Recertification Process for the officiating year 2010 that for most users will be completed 100% online. If you do not pass your Recertification Test you will have to register for and attend an instructor lead, in-class, closed book, "Re-Test" if you plan to officiate in 2010.

The process is as follows:

1. Go to the website <http://www.ctreferee.net> and select the link for eReferee Login.
2. Login using your USSF ID Number or First Name, Last Name and Birth Date. (be aware after 20 minutes of idle time the system will log you out and will not save any information you have entered. In particular, if you can not complete the Recertification Test within this timeframe be sure to save the questions you have answered as many times as you need; you will be able to logon and return to the Recertification Test and continue answering questions).
3. Click on a "NO" link under the 2010 Recertification Status Summary and proceed to the 2010 Detail Recertification page.
4. Background Check - Referees under 18 years will not see \"Background Check\" in their 2010 Detail Recertification page - Referees 18 years and older will have to complete the Background Check if they want to officiate any CJSA sponsored youth competitions.
5. Select the Referee "NO" link - select a clinic appropriate to your Referee grade, select multiple profiles (i.e. Assignor, Assessor or Instructor) as appropriate - select payment method (a credit card is best).
6. Proceed to the Memorandum - Read the Memorandum - Take the Memorandum Test (requires a 100% score to pass to the next section, you will have unlimited time and opportunities to pass).
7. Proceed to the Online Course - Read Online Course - Take the Online Course Test (requires a 100% score to pass to the next section, you will have unlimited time and opportunities to pass).
8. Proceed to the 50 question USSF Recertification Test - you must score 75% or higher to pass for a Grade 8 Referee (open book and unlimited time to complete the test, but only (2) opportunities to pass the Recertification Test, you may save the test unlimited times before submitting for grading).
9. If payment has been made and accepted and all testing has been passed, the 2010 Detail Recertification page will confirm recertification and you will be able to print your Recertification Certificate. A 2010 badge and law book will be sent by USSF. Registration Profiles for Referee Grades 7, 6, 5, 15, 13, Assignor, Assessor and Instructor may have other Recertification requirements, but will recertify in a similar manner through the online eReferee System. Referee Grades 7, 6, 5, 13 & 15 will have only (1) opportunity to pass their Recertification Test.

If a person was certified for 2008, but missed certifying for 2009, they can recertify for 2010. If they pass the Recertification Test, they can not officiate until January 1, 2010 even though they may receive their Referee badge before year end. All Referees who did not pass their "On-Line Recertification Test" will need to register, pay for and attend an instructor lead, in-class, closed book "Re-Test".
